• Ad Hoc Liaison Report

- Membership

 - Although there are 60 members who have not renewed, the committee determined that many of those players have not returned for the winter and it is expected they will renew after the holidays.

• Tennis Play

- Jason Morton tournament preparations are progressing. The Tournament Data Manager has been organized.
